### NRD MAPMAKER

NRD MapMaker is a web-based application that can be used to generate custom maps. The MapMaker system uses ESRI's ArcServer technology to deliver maps through a web browser.

Maps are interactive and can be panned, zoomed, queried, and printed according to your specifications.



### WHAT INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE?

Currently, MapMaker information is available for eastern Nebraska. In the future, coverage may be expanded to include other areas of the state.

Within the current coverage area of the system, a variety of information is available for use in generating custom maps, including:

- Cities
- Streams
- Lakes
- Major & Minor Roadways
- Aerial Photography from Farm Service Agency
- Census Tracts & Blocks
- Lower Platte River Corridor Alliance Boundaries
- Natural Resources District Boundaries
- County Boundaries
- Township Boundaries
- Soil Data (SSURGO)

This is not an exhaustive list; the system is continually updated as new coverages become available.
