

PLEASE NOTE NEW CHANGES TO PARK OPERATIONS DURING THE COVID-19 HEALTH EMERGENCY

Updated 6-12-2020

The Lake Wanahoo NRD Recreation Area continues to remain open.

The following are our NEW rules and regulations relating to this park:

- **If you have been sick in the last two weeks, PLEASE STAY AT HOME!**
 - **Please follow State of Nebraska/Three Rivers Directed Health Measures**
 - **Please maintain distance between you and other park visitors**
 - All camping sites without an "R" are first come, first served.
 - Online reservations are available for RV and tent camping.
 - Two vault toilets are open on the West side of the lake: one located at the boat ramp and one Southwest in the primitive camping area, and half of the shower building is open. One vault toilet on the East side of the lake is open. The remaining vault toilets remain closed.
 - Playgrounds are opened. Use at your own risk as they are not sanitized.
 - Avoid popular areas where people may congregate
 - Pack extra soap and/or hand sanitizer
 - If you feel canceling your stay is the safest choice, we will waive cancellation fees and reschedule your stay or return your unused rental payment. Please call our office at 402-443-4675
