Dear Mr. Gottschalk:

I am pleased to notify you that the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) has authorized Federal assistance for the Upper Wahoo Creek Watershed located in Saunders County, Nebraska.

Work on this project is being conducted under the authority of the Watershed Protection and Flood Prevention Act (Public Law 83-566) at the initiative of citizens in Nebraska. This project will provide flood prevention to agricultural and urban lands within the Upper Wahoo Creek Watershed and consists of 10 single-purpose floodwater retarding dams at locations identified to enhance flood risk reduction.

The cost of the Upper Wahoo Creek Watershed Project is estimated at \$19,667,600 of which \$11,661,000 will be paid by Public Law 83-566 funds and \$8,006,600 will be paid by the sponsor with local funding, as funds appropriated for this purpose are made available.

Enclosed is a signed copy of the Final Supplemental Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment for the Wahoo Creek Watershed.
