

Cottonwood 21-A is a high hazard structure in NW Saunders County

upstream of Malmo



Approximately one mile

• Drainage area: 1,427 acres

Conservation pool: 32 acres



PURPOSE & NEED

B PURPOSE

Address identified deficiencies of the Cottonwood 21-A structure and meet current design standards.





ONEED Reduce the potential risk to public safety due to the Cottonwood 21-A structure not meeting current design standards.





ALTERNATIVES TO CONSIDER

- LPNNRD will consider several alternatives including: Adding seepage drains Modifying the principal and auxiliary spillways

 - Property buyouts
 - Relocation
 - Purchase of expanded easement area • Flood-proofing or elevating existing homes to reduce the downstream flood hazards • Safely decommissioning the dam with a controlled breech

 - (removal) of the structure
