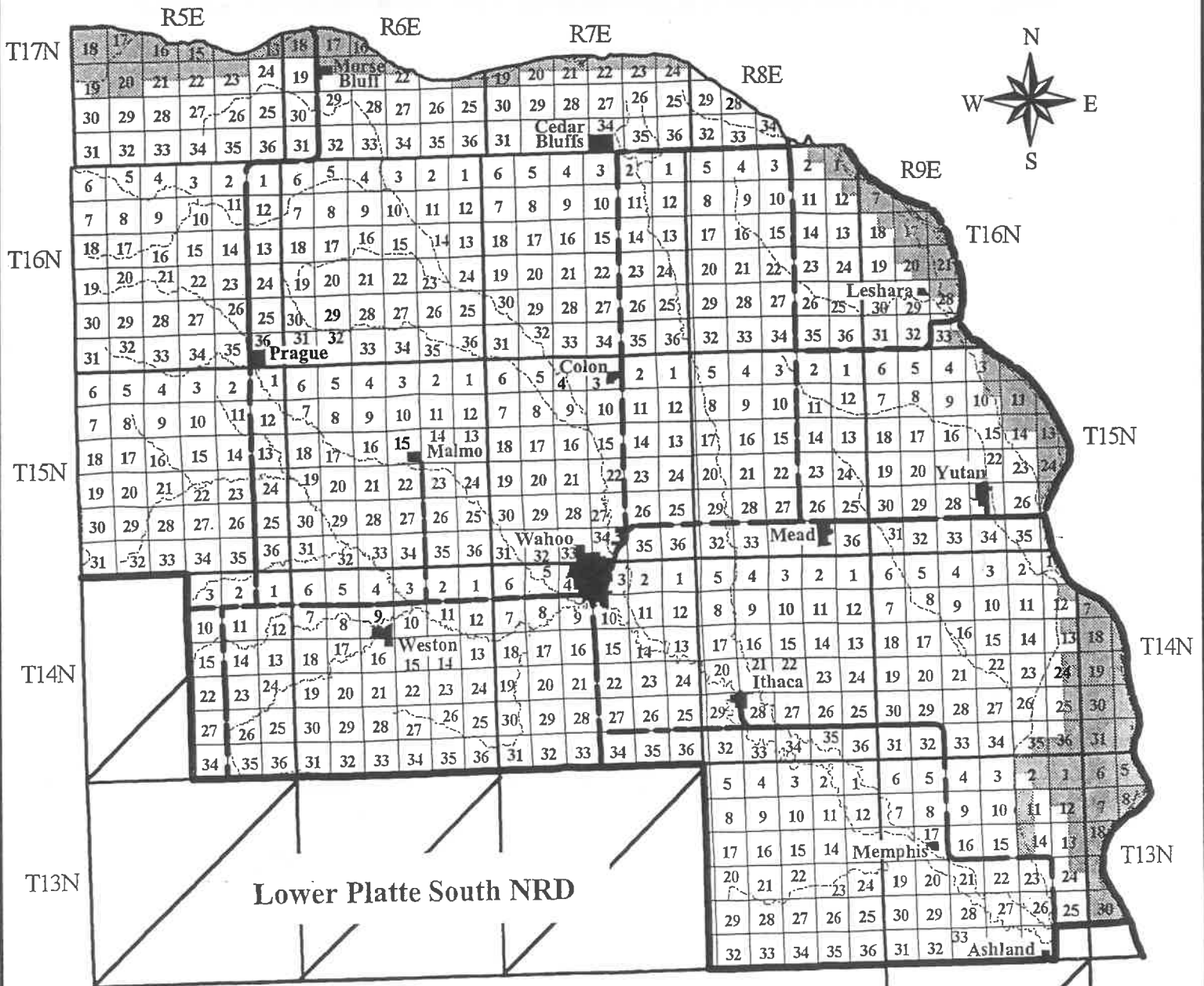


# Lower Platte North Natural Resources District Sandy Soils (Saunders County)
